What is the overall deductible?	Tier 1: \$300 member/\$900 familyTier 2: \$300 member/\$900 family Tier 3: \$300 member/\$900 family Benefits are administered on a Plan Year basis	Generally you must pay all the costs up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the policy, the overall family <u>deductible</u> must be met before the <u>plan</u> begins to pay.
Are there services covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> ?	Yes: emergency medical transportation, preventive care, provider office visits, prescription drugs, outpatient mental health services, rehabilitation services, habilitation services, routine eye exams, are covered before you meet your deductibles.	This <u>plan</u> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <u>deductible</u> amount. But, a <u>copayment</u> or <u>coinsurance</u> may apply. For example, this <u>plan</u> covers certain <u>preventive services</u> without <u>cost-sharing</u> and before you meet your <u>deductible</u> . Are there other deductibles for specific services?	No.	You don't have to meet <u>deductibles</u> for specific services
What is the out-of-pocket limit for this plan?	\$5,000 member/\$10,000 family.	The <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> is the most you could pay in a year of covered services. If you have other family members in this plan, they have to meet their own <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> until the overall family <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> has been met.

What is not included in the out-of-pocket limit?	Premiums, balance-billing charges, and health care this plan doesn't cover.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the out-of-pocket limit.
Will you pay less if you use a <u>network</u> provider?	Yes. See https://www.harvardpilgrim.org/public/find-a-provider or call 1-888-333-4742 for a list of preferred providers.	This plan uses a provider network. You will pay less if you use a provider in the plan's network. You will pay the most if you use an out-of-network provider, and you might receive a bill from a provider for the difference between the provider's charge and what your plan pays (balance-billing). Be aware, your network provider might use an out-of-network provider for some services (such as lab work). Check with your provider before you get services.
Do you need a referral to see a specialist?	Yes, some exceptions apply.	This <u>plan</u> will pay some or all of the costs to see a <u>specialist</u> for covered services but only if you have a <u>referral</u> before you see the <u>specialist</u> .
