What is the overall deductible?	Medical & Prescription Drug Deductible: \$2,000 member / \$4,000 family Benefits are administered on a Plan Year basis.	Generally you must pay all the costs up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <u>plan</u> , each family member must meet their own individual <u>deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <u>deductible</u> .
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?	Yes. <u>Preventive care</u> , <u>provider</u> office visits, <u>Tier</u> 1 prescription drugs, <u>Rehabilitation services</u> , and <u>Habilitation services</u> are covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> .	This <u>plan</u> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <u>deductible</u> amount. But, a <u>copayment</u> or <u>coinsurance</u> may apply.
