

# Building Healthy Communities

New Hampshire

Harvard Pilgrim Health Care Foundation provides the tools, training and leadership to build healthy communities. In 2014, the Foundation awarded nearly \$2.9 million in grants to 710 nonprofit organizations in Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts and New Hampshire.



## Investments in New Hampshire Communities:

**Harvard Pilgrim *Community Spirit 9/11 Mini-Grants Program*:** A total of \$21,500 was distributed through 43 mini-grants to employee-chosen nonprofit organizations in communities throughout the state.

**CATCH Kids Club (Across NH):** Helping children be healthier at 149 after school programs across the state, reaching nearly 6,600 children every day.

**NH Let's Go! Healthcare:** With Foundation support, *Let's Go!* engaged 9 pediatric practices throughout New Hampshire around the 5-2-1-0 message, reaching close to 65,000 patients with resources to improve their health.

**Healthy Cooking Classes with FEEDNH.org:** More than 200 youth at Boys & Girls Clubs in Nashua, Milford, Manchester, Laconia, Salem and Derry learned how to cook with chefs from Great NH Restaurants.

**Beech Street Elementary School (Manchester):** More than 75 volunteers from Harvard Pilgrim, the Manchester Monarchs, City Year, McLean Communications and Centrix Bank improved the school so students and the community can have a safe, bright space to learn, play, and be healthy.

**Spirit of NH Service Award:** For the 3<sup>rd</sup> time, our New Hampshire office received the [Spirit of New Hampshire Champion Award](#)! Given by Volunteer New Hampshire, this award recognizes outstanding businesses and nonprofit organizations whose work provides lasting impacts on New Hampshire communities and citizens.

**Culture InSight:** Through its training and consultation services, Culture InSight has developed and supports a core group of cultural competency trainers from 10 different healthcare organizations around the state.
