

Choosing an Ambulatory Surgical Center

If you or a covered family member needs to have an eye or a gastro-intestinal (GI) procedure, you will have a lower copayment when you choose an ambulatory surgical center instead of a hospital. We encourage you to speak with your provider about opportunities to have the procedure at an ambulatory surgical center.

Please note: You will pay a maximum of four copayments for ambulatory surgery per covered member on your plan, per plan year.



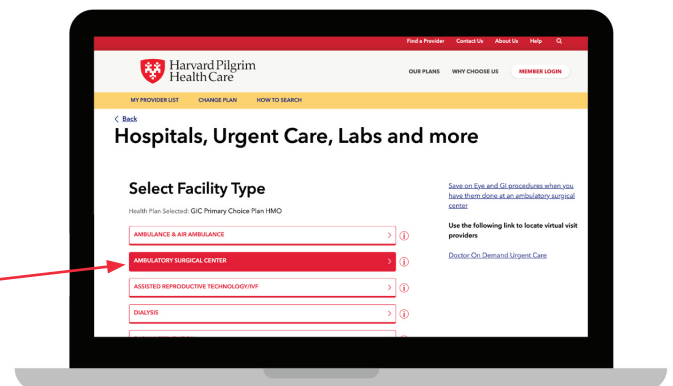
\$150 copayment for eye or GI procedures at an ambulatory surgical center.



\$250 copayment for eye or GI procedures at a hospital.

How to find ambulatory surgical centers

- 1 Visit harvardpilgrim.org/gic and click either "Harvard Pilgrim Quality HMO Provider Directory," "Harvard Pilgrim Explorer POS Provider Directory" or "Harvard Pilgrim Access America Provider Directory" under "2023 - 2024 Annual Enrollment Information."
- 2 Click "Hospitals, Urgent Care, Labs and more" on the right, then select "Ambulatory Surgical Center" from the list.
