What is the overall deductible?	Medical & Prescription Drug Deductible: Tier 1: \$1,400 member / \$2,800 family Tier 2: \$2,800 member / \$5,600 family Benefits are administered on a calendar year basis.	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from providers up to the deductible amount before this plan begins to pay. If you have other family members on the plan, each family member must meet their own individual deductible until the total amount of deductible expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family deductible.
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?	Yes. Preventive care, Tiers 1, 2, and 3 prescription drugs, and the following Tier 1 Provider services: provider office visits, Rehabilitation services, and Habilitation services are covered before you meet your deductible.	This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. But a copayment or coinsurance may apply. For example, this plan covers certain preventive services without cost-sharing and before you meet your deductible. What is the <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> for this <u>plan</u> ?	\$7,500 member / \$15,000 family	The <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this <u>plan</u> , they have to meet their own <u>out-of-pocket limits</u> until the overall family <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> has been met.
