If you have other family members on the plan, each family member must meet their own individual deductible until the total amount of deductible expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family deductible.</p>
<p>Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?</p>	<p>Yes. Preventive care and routine eye exams are covered before you meet your deductible.</p>	<p>This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. But, a copayment or coinsurance may apply. For example, this plan covers certain preventive services without cost-sharing and before you meet your deductible. <p>What is the out-of-pocket limit for this plan?</p>	<p>\$6,900 member / \$13,800 family</p>	<p>The out-of-pocket limit is the most you could pay in a year of covered services. If you have other family members in this plan, they have to meet their own out-of-pocket limit until the overall family out-of-pocket limit has been met.</p>

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What is not included in the <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> ?	Pediatric Dental Care, premiums, balance-billed charges, and health care this plan doesn't cover.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> .
Will you pay less if you use a <u>network provider</u> ?	Yes. See https://www.harvardpilgrim.org/public/find-a-provider or call 1-888-333-4742 for a list of <u>preferred providers</u> .	This <u>plan</u> uses a <u>provider network</u> . You will pay less if you use a <u>provider</u> in the plan's <u>network</u> . You will pay the most if you use an <u>out-of-network provider</u> , and you might receive a bill from a <u>provider</u> for the difference between the provider's charge and what your <u>plan</u> pays (<u>balance-billing</u>).
