What is the overall <a href="#">deductible</a> ?	<b>Medical &amp; Prescription Drug Deductible:</b> \$2,750 member / \$5,500 family Benefits are administered on a Plan Year basis.	Generally you must pay all the costs up to the <a href="#">deductible</a> amount before this <a href="#">plan</a> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <a href="#">plan</a> , each family member must meet their own individual <a href="#">deductible</a> until the total amount of <a href="#">deductible</a> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <a href="#">deductible</a> .
Are there services covered before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a> ?	Yes. <a href="#">Preventive care</a> , Tier 1 prescription drugs, and routine eye exams are covered before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a> .
